



Drug Policy
Revised September 21, 2011

On occasion the school receives reports that certain students are openly advocating drug use and/or experimentation. These reports are of grave concern to us. We want to send a clear message to those individuals that there will be no tolerance for this type of behavior.

Accordingly, it may be necessary when there is reasonable suspicion, to require that a student submit to a drug test during a specified period of time. Compliance with this request may be made a condition for the student to resume/continue classes.

Steps the school will follow when there is suspicion of drug use:

1. The school health officer will conduct a neurological exam in the presence of a school administrator.
2. If after the neurological exam, the student appears to be impaired, parents will be contacted and asked to pick up their student.
3. The parent or guardian will then be requested to take their child to a lab for drug testing.*
4. The administration requests that the laboratory report results should be sent directly to school administration.
5. Administration will follow up with the parents and student.**

* Administration can provide parents with a list of laboratories in the area.

**The school treats all drug test results as confidential information.

Consequences for use of an illegal substance may include but are not limited to:

1. Suspension from school
2. Behavioral Probation with student contract
3. Required counseling
4. Regular drug testing
5. Expulsion
